
Barcoding / Jumbo Numbers



Barcodes are applied to products to quickly identify them. They are typically used in retail stores as a part of the purchasing process, in warehouses to track and manage inventory, on invoices to help with accounting, and in shipping to track packages. They are widely used in healthcare for hospital forms ranging from patient identification to medication management. They are also used to facilitate the separation and indexing of documents in libraries.

Common barcodes used at 5 Day Business Forms are Code 39, Code 128, and Interleaved 2 of 5.
